In exercise of the powers conferred by the Indian Electricity (Supply) Act, 1948, the Punjab State Elec. Board is pleased to make the following Regulations governing the conditions of PSEB Supervisory Accounts Services Examinations, namely :-

REGULATIONS

1. (i) SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

These regulations may be called, "the Pb. State Elec. Board Supervisory Accounts Service (Examination) Regulations, 1970".

(ii) These regulations shall come into force with effect from 30.7.1970.

Note:- The examinations held and results announced during the period from 30.7.70 to the date of issue of these regulations shall be a closed chapter and no matter connected therewith shall be re-opened on any ground, whatsoever.

(iii) These regulations shall be applicable to all candidates appearing in the Board's Supervisory Accounts Service, except direct recruits from the open market, who shall be governed by separate orders.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND SCOPE

a) Any regular employee of Pb. State Elec. Board with two years regular service on the ministerial side viz. Head Readers, L.D.Cs., U.D.Cs., Store-Keepers & Asstt. Store-Keepers, Circle Assistants, Asstt. Revenue Accountants, Internal Auditors, Head Clerks, Jr. Scale Stenographers, Sr. Scale Stenographers, Head Office Assistants and S.G.Cs.) who have passed the Departmental Accounts Examination for Ministerial Estt. shall be eligible to appear in Part I of the S.A.S. Examination of the Board.

Note: The term 'L.D.Cs.' shall not include "apprentice L.D.Cs."

b) The maximum number of chances for the two parts of the examination will be limited to 10 chances of which not more than 6 chances may be taken for passing Part I of the examination. Secretary may give extra chances in deserving

The Punjab State Elec. Board is pleased to add the following in the S.A.S. Regulations, 1970, at the end of sub clause 4(b) of clause 4 "Limit of Pass Marks".

"However, the chances for clearing the remaining paper will be restricted to three whereafter the candidate will have to appear in all the subjects afresh. Such a candidate can choose to appear in all the papers under clause 4(a) except in those papers where he has obtained 60% exemption marks at the time he opted to appear under clause 4(a).

2. The amendment shall come into operation w.e.f. 15.7.74.

3. The Board in the said meeting has also decided that the benefit of clause 4(b) would be available to a candidate who secures exemption marks in one paper and obtains pass marks in two papers in a subsequent examination.

Subject:- Supervisory Accounts Service (Examination)
Regulations, 1970.

In the past, a candidate who has passed three out of four papers of any part of SAS examination was required to obtain 60% marks in the remaining subject- viz. in the subject in which he has not secured a pass earlier, in terms of clause 4(b) of the regulations cited as subject. Now the P.S.E.B. in its 298th Meeting held at Patiala on 16.1.1979 has decided that in future, the candidates shall have to obtain 50% marks in the remaining subject.

2. Clause 2(c) of the said regulations envisages that a candidate who has passed Part I of the S.A.S.

cases with the concurrence of the A.M. Permission to an official to appear at a particular examination will count as a chance unless he is allowed by the Secretary to withdraw his name with the approval of the A.M. Such withdrawals will not be allowed unless the circumstances of the case fully justify the concession.

c) A candidate who has passed Part I of the S.A.S. Examination shall be required to serve as Divisional/Revenue Acctt. for one year in a Division/Sub Divisional Office/ Pramadit Office, GDP, Bhatinda before he is allowed to appear in Part II of the Examination. After getting necessary training, he will submit his application on the prescribed form (Appendix C) when the date of the examination is notified. Those who successfully negotiate Part II shall be eligible for appointment as S.A.S. Accountants in the regular scale.

3. SUBJECTS OF THE EXAMINATION.

The subjects of the examination both Part I and Part II and the maximum marks assigned to each subject are given in Appendix 'A'.

4. PASS MARKS

a) A candidate who secures atleast 45% marks in the each subject shall be declared successful. A candidate, though failing in the examination but secured a minimum of 60% marks in any subject shall be exempted in that subject.

b) A candidate who has passed three out of the four subjects of any part of S.A.S. Examination shall have to obtain 60% marks in remaining subject viz. in the subject in which he has not secured a pass earlier.

5. CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION.

a) The examination shall be held twice a year, sometimes in June/July and November/December for both these parts. The Secretary with the concurrence of the A.M., shall be empowered to change this time schedule, if so necessitated by administrative reasons. The date sheet of the examination shall be notified by the Secretary well before the commencement of the examination. The eligible candidates desirous of appearing in the examination shall submit his application on the prescribed form (Appendix 'B') through the Head of the Office by a date not later than the date specified by the Secretary. The application shall be forwarded direct to the secretary adding remarks as to the

character, business habits and of the prospects of the candidate's success in the examination. No application received after the date shall be entertained. Candidates who are allowed to appear in the examination shall be assigned roll numbers, which shall be communicated to them through their heads of the offices.

(b) No candidate may enter the examination hall before or after half an hour of the commencement of the examination. No candidate can leave the examination hall before the expiry of half time. In special case the Supervising Officer may allow any candidate to leave the examination hall even before the expiry of half-time in case he is satisfied that the candidate is not feeling well. But in such circumstances, it would be obligatory on the part of the leaving candidate to ensure strict secrecy, leaving the question paper with the Supervising Officer and should not disclose the contents of the paper to any outside agency to obviate malpractices. When a candidate temporarily leaves the hall during the official period of the examination, the Supervising Officer must take effectual means of ensuring that he makes no improper use of his absence.

5-A: All pages of the answer book will bear stamped signatures of the officer incharge of the examination in Secretary's office. No page of the answer book should on any account be removed by the candidate.

6. SETTING OF PAPERS AND EVALUATION OF ANSWER BOOKS

The papers on all the subjects shall be set and evaluated by the officers nominated by the Secretary, P.S.U., with the concurrence of the A.M. The question papers set by the examiner shall be reviewed by the Secretary before these are got cyclostyled/rinted by the Superintendent /Examination. The sealed envelope containing question papers of each subject shall be kept under lock and key with the Superintendent /Examination and the sealed envelope of the paper concerned handed over to the Supervising Officer before the commencement of examination. The sealed envelope should be opened by the Supervising Officer in the presence of another Gazetted Officer and the candidates and the number of question papers specified on the envelope checked and then distributed to the candidates. The Supervising Officer and other should be present in the examination hall all the time

the candidates are answering the papers and no outsider should be permitted to enter the examination hall except the staff necessary to serve drinking water, blank papers and similar requirements.

6-A: The names of books the use of which is permitted for each practical paper should be mentioned in the question paper itself by the officer who sets the paper, and other books shall be prohibited from use at the particular examination. The names of books to be allowed for such paper are noted on the covers containing question papers. At the close of each days examination the names of the books for the next days examination should be announced by the Supervisory Officer so that the number of books to be brought into the examination hall by the candidates may be kept as minimum as possible.

7. INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EXAMINERS.

The candidates shall observe strictly the instructions printed on the blank answer books as reproduced in Appendix 'D'. Violation thereof shall be viewed seriously. While leaving the examination hall the candidates shall hand over his answer book to the Supervising Officer even if it is blank. In no case any paper of the answer book should be torn out / removed or shall not be taken out of the examination hall. Immediately, after the close of the examination, the answer books should be checked and handed over to the Supdt. / Examination after crossing of the blank papers therein. The officer conducting the examination shall also furnish a statement giving the number of candidates who took up the examination and also those who did not appear indicating inter alia the answer books used by each examinee. He shall also obtain/attested specimen signatures from each candidate on the first day of entry in the hall. He shall also obtain signature of each candidate daily in token of his presence. A certificate in the following form shall also be furnished by him to the Superintendent / Exam. at the close of the examination :-

8. USE OF UNFAIR MEANS IN THE EXAMINATION:

i) Candidate(s) found using unfair means in the examination hall and/or in possession of books/readymade notes etc. shall be expelled from the examination hall and will not be allowed to attempt the remaining papers - besides their answer books taken over by the Supervising Officer (s).

ii) Candidate(s) as are found using unfair means in the examination hall shall not be allowed to sit in the examination on the next day of examination besides debarring them from appearing in the examination for the next 4 sessions and also issuing letters of waiving to them copies whereof shall also be placed in their Q.R. Files.

iii) Candidate(s) absconding with their answer books from the examination hall, shall render themselves liable for stoppage of their one increment with future effect. Besides, they will be debarred from appearing in the exam. for atleast two years. Of course, the penalty of stoppage of one increment with future effect, as envisaged above, shall be inflicted after observing the regular procedure, viz., service of Show Cause Notice.

Appeals against such punishment could, however, be made to the Secretary Board who shall be appellate authority in such cases.

9. RESULT

The complete result of the examination shall be communicated by the Secretary, after approval by the A.M. to each candidate for his information. Black lists to failed candidate shall also invariably be sent by the Secretary. The candidates shall also be informed about their detailed marks obtained in each paper whether passed or not. No appeal shall lie against the result declared by the Secretary.

10. INTRODUCTION OF TRAINING CLASSES FOR THE EXAMINATION.

Subject to any general or special instructions issued by the Board from time to time, arrangements for holding training classes outside office hours shall be made by the Secretary in consultation with the A.M. for the benefit of the candidates for Part I and II of the examination. In addition to the theoretical instructions, the candidates shall be given training in practical work.

11. HONORARIUM FOR THE EXAMINATION AND IMPARTING TRAINING.

Honorarium shall be allowed to the examiners and the Officer holding training classes at the following rates :-

- i) For setting the question paper. Rs. 75/-
- ii) For evaluating the answer books Rs. 2/- per answer book.
- iii) Honorarium @ Rs. 8/- and Rs. 5/- per lecture shall be allowed to the Sr. Accounts Officer and Accounts Officer respectively, deputed for training the respective candidates.

11-A: RECHECKING OF PAPERS.

The failed candidates are allowed an opportunity to get their particular paper/s rechecked and accordingly, the following procedure is laid down for the purpose :-

- a) The failed candidate will deposit a sum of Rs. 50/- per paper which he intends to get re-examined, in any of the Sub Divisional/Divisional Offices of the Board under Head "D-Other Revenue Misc. Items".
- b) The failed candidate will submit an application to the Secretary indicating the following particulars alongwith the original receipt referred to in (a) above :-
 1. Name of the Examination.
 2. Session.
 3. Particular of paper which is to be re-examined.
 4. Roll No. under which appeared.

- c) On receipt of application, complete in all respects, in the office of the Secretary/Examination, re-checking of the particular paper/s will be made in the presence of the Secretary/Examination Branch. The checking will be restricted to ensure whether the totalling of the answer book/s has been correctly made and no question or part thereof has been left by the Examiner unmarked. The re-checking is not intended for re-evaluating the answer book/s of the failed candidate.
- d) No application will be entertained if it is submitted after 39 days of the declaration of the result of a particular examination. The result of re-checking will be communicated to the candidate within 15 days of the receipt of his application.
- e) While re-checking the answer books of any failed candidate the answer books shall, in no case, be shown to the candidate concerned or his representative. However, to ensure that the answer books actually pertained to a particular candidate he shall send his specimen hand-writing running into 15/20 lines alongwith his application seeking re-checking in the papers, which shall invariably be compared with all the answer books of the failed candidate concerned.
- f) The fee of Rs.50/- per paper deposited by the candidate shall be refundable, in case any discrepancy is noticed in the result once declared but if status-quo is maintained the fees so deposited shall be forfeited.

12. APPLICATION OF THESE REGULATIONS TO THE QUALIFIED DIVISIONAL/REVENUE ACCOUNTANTS.

The existing qualified Divisional/Revenue Accountants shall be deemed to have passed Part I of the S.A.S. Examination and those who had secured exemption marks in any paper of the existing syllabus of

Divisional/Revenue Accountants Examination will be considered to have secured exemption marks in the corresponding paper(s) of Part I of the S.A.S. Examination.

12-4: GENERAL

1. The grant of exemption shall be considered by the Board, in extremely hard cases on the following considerations :-

- a) The official making the request has attained the age of 50 years.
- b) The record of the official is consistently good and without blemish; and
- c) The official has atleast made (four) attempts to clear the examinations.

2. Once exemption has been granted to an official no disability, whatsoever, shall attach to him in order to consider him for further promotions.

13. AMENDMENTS IN THE REGULATIONS:

No change shall be made by any other authority in the regulations except by the Board. Whenever there is any such occasion, the Secretary shall submit concrete proposals to the Board, for its approval, whereafter, such a change shall be notified. As regard any doubt to the interpretation of these regulations, the clarifications issued by the Secretary shall be final.

There being no set rules/regulations for the grant of grace marks to the candidates of various Accounts Examinations failing by a margin, the Punjab State Elec. Board in its 310th meeting held at Patiala on 19.1.90, decided to allow grace marks as under :-

1. Departmental Accounts Examination for Engineer Officers/SAS Part I & II.

Grace marks upto five will be allowed to a candidate who appears in one attempt in all the four papers but passes in three papers and is short of marks in upto that extent in one paper. No grace marks will be allowed in other cases.

2. Departmental Accounts Examination for Ministerial Estt.

a) Grace marks upto five will be allowed to a candidate who appears in all the four papers in one attempt, passes in three papers and is short of marks upto that extent in one paper.

b) A candidate will, however, be allowed three grace/pass marks in each group viz. Group-I (Paper I & II) and Group-II (Paper III & IV) separately if he otherwise passes in the second paper of that group.

c) In the case of Store-Keeping Estt., who are required to appear only in Paper V no grace marks will be allowed.

The above decision will be effective from the date of issue.

3. A candidate will be declared pass in the examination as-a-whole when he clears all papers of the particular part in one or more attempts.
4. Grace marks upto five will be allowed to a candidate who appears in one attempt in all the four papers but passes in three papers and is short of marks upto that extent in one paper. No grace marks will be allowed in other cases.

II. PSEB Rules for Departmental Accounts Examination for Engineering Subordinate.
Regulation 3(ii) & (iii) - (Subject & Pass Percentage)

- 3(ii) A candidate who obtains 40% or more marks in any paper in any attempt will be declared pass in that paper and will appear in the remaining paper only in subsequent attempts.
- 3(iii) Grace marks upto five will be allowed to a candidate who appears in one attempt in both the papers and is short of marks upto that extent in one paper. No grace marks will be allowed in other cases.

III. PSEN Engineer Officers Departmental Examination
Regulation No. 10 (Pass, Disqualification)

- i) A candidate who obtains 40% marks in any paper in any attempt will be declared pass in that paper.
- ii) Candidates who pass one or more papers in any attempt will not be required to appear again in those papers and will appear in the remaining paper/s only in subsequent attempts.
- iii) A candidate will be declared pass in the examination as-a-whole when he clears all the four papers in one or more attempts.

Regulation No. 11 (Grace Marks)

Grace Marks upto five will be allowed to a candidate who appears in one attempt in all the four papers, but passes in three papers, and is short of marks upto that extent in one paper. No grace marks shall be allowed in other cases.

IV. Rules for the Departmental Accounts Examination
of Ministerial Establishment in the Heavy Branch
Regulation 12 (Limit of Pass Marks)

- i) A candidate who obtains 40% marks in any paper in any attempt will be declared pass in that paper.
- ii) Candidates who pass one or more papers in any attempt will not be required to appear again in those paper and will appear in the remaining paper/s only in subsequent attempts.
- iii) A candidate will be declared pass in the examination as-a-whole when he clears all the four papers in one or more attempts.
- iv) Grace marks upto five will be allowed to a candidate who appears in one attempt in all the four papers, but passes in the three papers, and is short of marks upto that extent in one paper. No grace marks shall be allowed in other cases.

In exercise of the powers conferred under section-79(c) of the Electricity (Supply) Act-1948, the Punjab State Electricity Board is pleased to make the following amendment (13th Amendment) in the PSES Supervisory Accounts Service (Examination) Regulations-1973, namely:-

A M E N D M E N T

Regulation-4 (Pass-2)

The existing Regulation-4 of said Regulations shall be substituted with the following:-

(4) PASS MARKS

- (i) A candidate shall appear in all the four papers at a time in S. S. (Examination) Part-I/Part-II, as the case may be, unless he has secured exemption in one or more paper(s).
- (ii) A candidate securing 50% or more marks in a paper(s) shall be exempted from re-appearing in said paper(s).
- (iii) A candidate who secures 50% or more marks in every paper and atleast 50% marks in overall aggregate shall be declared pass in any part of SAS Exam.
- (iv) Grace marks upto five will be allowed to a candidate who appears in one attempt in all the four papers but passes in three/four papers and is short of prescribed pass percentage in one paper or in aggregate or in both.

3. The candidates who have cleared one, two or three paper(s) under old regulations will have the option to continue to be governed by those regulations upto next two sessions provided they are otherwise eligible to appear. Thereafter such candidates will have to appear in all the papers of SAS (Examination) Part-I or Part-II as the case may be, as a fresh candidate under these regulations.

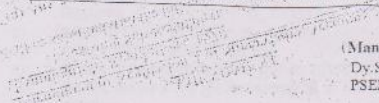

The Punjab State Elec. Board is pleased to make the following amendments in the P.S.E.B. Supervisory Accounts Services (Examination) Regulations 1970, namely:-

AMENDMENT

I. REGULATION 2(c).

Sub Regulation (c) of Regulation 2 of the PSEB Supervisory Accounts Services (Examination) Regulations, 1970, shall be deleted.

II. REGULATION 4(b).

Sub regulation (b) of Regulation 4 of the PSEB Supervisory Accounts Services (Examination) Regulations, 1970, shall be substituted with the following :-

- (b) A candidate who passed three out of the four papers of any part of GAS Examination shall have to obtain 50% exemption marks in the remaining subject viz. in the subject in which he has not secured a pass earlier.

However, the chances for clearing the remaining paper will be restricted to three where-after the candidate will have to appear in all the subjects afresh. Such a candidate can choose to appear in all the papers under clause 4(c) except in those papers where he has obtained 50% exemption marks at the time he opted to appear under clause 4(a)..

NOTE: "A candidate securing exemption marks in one paper in an examination and obtaining pass marks in two papers in a subsequent examination shall be declared pass under this sub clause".
