1. A Set of tender documents (Non-transferable) containing detailed technical specifications, General instructions and terms & conditions can be obtained from the office of Dy CE/Headquarter, GGSSTP, P.O. Ghanauli, Ropar-140113 on payment of Rs1000/-plus GST @18%(or as applicable)by cash or demand draft, drawn in favor of Accounts officer, GGSSTP, PSPCL, Ropar and payable at Ropar. Tenders of the firms who do not purchase the tender documents in advance, shall not be opened.
2. All tenders must be accompanied by earnest money at the rates prescribed in the tender documents except in the case of those tenderers who are specifically exempted there under.
3. Telegraphic / Fax/e-mail quotations shall not be accepted.
4. Negotiations shall not be held except with the lowest tenderer.
5. **The perspective bidders are requested to visit the PSPCL website www.pspcl.in periodically even after purchasing the specifications from this office to check for corrigendum issued, if any. No corrigendum shall be published in newspaper.**
6. The firm shall have independent EPF Code Number issued from the concerned RPF authority. Sub code from the office of RPFC Chandigarh will be required.
7. The firm should have independent Service Tax Registration No. and will submit a copy of the same.
8. The firm shall have to obtain license under Contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act-1970 for CHP before commencement of work and shall abide by various provisions/ rules framed there under.

1. Tenders of the firms who do not purchase the tender documents in advance, shall not be opened.

A. Prequalifying Requirements:-

Tenders of only those technically suitable firm/contractor will be who are registered with PSPCL/ PSTCL or NTPC and other such Central Govt. Organizations(on submission of valid registration certificates) for mechanical jobs subject to fulfilling of the following PQRs :-

- B. The bidder should have proof of having successfully completed/ being executed the following jobs of Erection/ Fabrication/ Replacement/ Repair of Pipelines/Steel structures in Coal Handling Plant/Cement Plant/Mining industry/ Hydrel/ Thermal/ Nuclear Plants or similar work during the last seven years ending on 31.05.2025 either of following:-

- i) Single, completed/ being executed work order covering not less than Rs 1,65,000/- (including all taxes).
- OR
- ii) Two, completed/ being executed, work orders, not less than Rs 99,000/- (including all taxes).
- OR
- iii) Three, completed / being executed, work orders, not less than Rs 82,500/- (including all taxes).

- C. **Annual Turn Over:** Firms minimum average annual turnover during the last three years should be Rs 1,65,000/- ending 31st March of previous financial year i.e. 2024-25.

- D. **Bank Solvency:** The firm should have sound financial capability & should submit latest solvency certificate from a Nationalized Bank/Scheduled Commercial Bank for an amount not less than Rs 3.30 Lakhs. Bank Solvency certificate should not be more than 12 months old.

2. Requirement for Registration

Those tenderers who fulfill the requirement of PQR and consider themselves eligible for participation can get themselves registered with GGSSTP by submitting the attested copies of followings documents along with non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 1000/-+ GST@18% (Rs. - i. Copies of work orders and completion certificates for experience as per PQR.
 - ii. Copies of Audited balance sheets over during the last three financial years, ending 31st March of previous financial year.
 - iii. Bank solvency of minimum Rs. 3.5 Lacs. Bank solvency certificate should not be more than 12 months old. Average annual financial turn over during the last three year, ending March of the previous financial year, should be at least Rs. 1.75 Lacs.
 - iv. Proof of PAN and Proof of Goods and service tax (GST) registration number.
 - v. Proof of independent EPF account number.
 - vi. EPF clearance certificate: EPF clearance certificate for last financial year needs to be obtained. In the event of non-availability of clearance certificate proof of deposit of EPF for last two years shall be required.
 - vii. Proof of having ESI Code number.
 - viii. An Affidavit in original dully attested by an Executive Magistrate/Notary to the effect that :
 - a. The firm is not defaulter in respect of deposition of EPF/ESI to the concerned EPF/ESI department for workers deployed against work orders placed by PSPCL or any other organization on it during last five years. In any case, the responsibility for deposition of EPF/ESI of workers engaged by the firm shall rest with the firm only. In case firm is found defaulter at any stage in this regard, the contract shall be cancelled without any notice.
 - b. That the firm has not been black listed by any government/public sector undertaking during the last 5 years.
4. EMD: - The tenderers shall be required to submit earnest money of Rs 7000/- (Rs. Seven Thousand Only), through demand draft in favour of AO/GGSSTP, PSPCL, Ropar payable at Ropar.
Public sector undertakings fully owned by Punjab Government/center Government/ Other state Government shall be exempted from depositing earnest money, provided that the certificate of Government ownership shall be submitted in envelope for Earnest Money.
5. The firm shall have an independent EPF code number issued from the concerned RPFC authority.
 6. The firm shall have to obtain license under Contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act-1970 before undertaking the work and shall abide by various provisions/rules framed there under.
 7. The firm shall have valid GST no. and are registered with the concerned Department.
 8. The firm shall comply with all the regulations of ESI act, amended for time to time and shall keep PSPCL free from any liability arising at any stage.
 9. CE/O&M GGSSTP Rupnagar reserves the right to refuse issue of tender documents to any contractor/ firm without assigning any reason and also to reject any or all offers without assigning any reason and no claim on this account will be accepted.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR TENDERS

1. Tender documents will be issued to only those technically suitable firms who are either already registered for Steel Fabrication work in Coal Handling Plant/Cement Plant/Mining industry or similar work or who will get themselves registered for this job
2. The tender must be valid for at-least 120 days from the date of opening of tenders.
3. Tenders received telegraphically, through e-mail, telex or fax shall not be accepted.
4. GGSSTP reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason and no claim on this account shall be accepted.
5. Tenders received after the last date and time of receipt of tenders shall not be accepted. If the due date happened to be holiday, tenders shall be received and opened on next working day at the same time.
6. The tenderers shall specify clearly his rates as per Performa attached as Annexure-B. Hand written rates shall not be accepted.
7. Tenders received without Earnest money shall not be opened.
8. The firm shall have independent EPF code Number issued from the concerned RPF authority. Sub code from the Office of Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, Chandigarh will be required.
9. The contractor should have independent GST no. allotted & will submit a copy of the same.
10. The firm shall follow the Rules and Regulations of Employees State Insurance Act, 1948. The firm is required to get itself registered with ESI. However, in any case, the registration of the firm will be done but the firm will be required to submit its registration certificate with ESI before issue of Work order.
11. Firms must get register themselves as mentioned in terms & condition
12. The firm shall have to obtain license under contract Labour Regulation and abolition Act, 1970 before undertaking the work and shall abide by various provisions/rules framed hereunder.
13. **SOLVENCY CERTIFICATE:-** Every tenderer shall produce along with his tender a solvency certificate from a scheduled Bank. If he fails to produce such a certificate, his tender may not be considered
14. **Bid should be submitted in two parts.**
 - Part-I : Tender document fee & Earnest Money Deposit.
 - Part-II : Commercial, Technical bid and price bid.
15. The tenderers shall be required to submit earnest money as per Rules and Regulations of PSPCL. Tenders of the bidders who do not submit fee towards earnest money shall not be opened. Public Sector Undertakings fully owned by the Punjab Govt./ Central Govt./Other State Govt. shall be exempted from depositing Earnest Money provided that a certificate of Govt. Ownership shall be submitted in the envelope for Earnest Money. In case of tenders are not accepted the earnest money shall be refunded.
16. Firms which are registered with MSME are required to provide documentary evidence (Latest copy of memorandum of Micro Small & Medium Enterprises filed under section-8 of MSMED Act, 2006 duly acknowledged by competent authority.) of being a Micro, Small & Medium Enterprise. If the bidder does not submit the proof at the time of submission of its bid, it shall be considered as a large enterprise.
A certificate for the last financial year duly signed by any Director / Partner / Proprietor and Chartered Accountant that investment in Plant & Machinery of the enterprise does not exceed Rs. 25 Lac in case of micro and Rs. 5.00 Cr in case of small enterprise as prescribed in section 7 (1) a (i) & (ii) of the MSMED Act, 2006.
17. Tender of only registered firm shall be opened. Part -I (Tender document fee & Earnest Money Deposit) shall be opened first, if Part-I is found to be in order, then Part-II (Techno-commercial Bid-Price bid) shall be opened. The tenderer should send the hard copies of all documents, proof of tender document fees, EMD, price bid.
