Subject.-

Determination of higher and lower posts for the purposes of promotion/pay fixation.

Sir,

I am directed to draw your attention to the subject noted above and to say that all the revised pay scales form part of a running master scale of Rs.750-20-950-25-1200-30-1560-40-2000-50-2400-60-2700-75-3000-100-4000-125-5000-150-5900-200-6700 and thus the rates of increments at the same stages of the revised scales are the same. Further, vide office order No. 170/Fin/PRC-1983 dated 27.8.89, the Board employee can be allowed ex-gratia annual anti-stagnation increments at the same rates as are given in the master scale subject to the condition that in no case the basic pay of the Board employee shall exceed seven thousand and three hundred rupees. Again, vide office order No. 183/Fin/PRC-1983 dated 15.1.90 the pay of a Board employee on promotion can be fixed beyond the maximum of his pay scale and promotional increments/ proficiency increments can also be granted to him at the stage beyond the maximum of his scale subject to the ceiling of Rs. 7300. In nutshell,

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At present, the revised pay scales being parts of a master scale, have uniform rates of increments and the maximum limit upto which the pay scales be extended is seven thousand and three hundred rupees and thus practically the pay scales now differ only at the minimum.

2. Besides, vide office order No. 283/Fin/PRC-1988 dated 26.11.92 promotional increments are also allowed when the time scales of both the higher and lower posts are the same or identical provided it is certified that the higher post involves assumption of duties and responsibilities of greater importance than those attached to the lower post, and, in the note below paragraph-2 of this order, it has been stated that the question whether the higher post in the same or identical scale carries duties and responsibilities of greater importance than those attached to the lower post shall be determined by the Administrative Department in consultation with the Department of Finance. With the coming into force of the provisions of this order, the provisions of Regulation 4.14 (3) of the PSEB Main Services Regulations-1972, Volume-I Part-I according to which the officiating appointment on a higher post is not deemed to involve assumption of duties or responsibilities of greater importance of the post to which it is made is on the same scale of pay as the permanent lower post or on a scale of pay identical therewith, stand over ridden as the amendment made vide the said order, dated 26.11.92, in the Punjab State Electricity Board(Revised Pay) regulations-1988 has the over-riding effect on the provisions of the PSEB Main Services Regulations-1972 Volume-I Part-I by virtue of regulation-11 of the said Revised Pay Regulations of 1988 notified vide office order No. 129/Fin/PRC-1988 dated 11.11.1988.

3. In view of the position explained in the preceding paragraphs, the guidelines for determining the relative degree of duties and responsibilities of two posts for the purposes of fixation of pay etc. i.e. the determining the higher post etc.

posts shall be as under:-

- a) A Post having the lower minimum basic time-scale of pay shall generally be considered the lower post as compared to a post having higher minimum of the basic scale and for this purpose senior scale/selection grade of the post generally given after 8/12 years of service or so shall not be taken into account.
- b) Where the minimum of the basic time scale of pay of the two posts is the same, the post having higher maximum of the basic scale shall be considered the higher post.
- c) Where the time scale of both the higher and lower posts are identical, the higher and lower posts shall be determined in accordance with the provisions contained in Boards office order No. 263/Fin/PRC-1988 dated the 26th November, 1992 as explained in paragraph-2 of this letter.

4. If, however, there is still some doubt about any posts being higher or lower, the matter shall be determined by the Administrative Department in consultation with the Department of Finance.

5. The above instructions may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict observance.

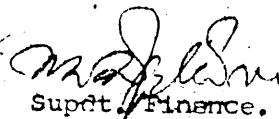

In continuation of this office order No.444/Fin-38/Vol.VII dated 4.5.92, the Punjab State Electricity Board on the pattern of Punjab Govt. is pleased to decide that the rates of Dearness Allowance payable to the employees of the Board shall stand modified with effect from 1st July, 1992 as follows:-

Date from which payable.	Pay Range	Rate of Dearness Allowance per mensem
1st July, 1992	Basic pay upto Rs.3,500 per mensem.	83 per cent of pay.
	Basic pay above Rs.3,500 per mensem and upto Rs.6,000 per mensem.	62 per cent of pay subject to a minimum of Rs. 2,905.
	Basic pay above Rs.6,000 per mensem.	54 per cent of pay subject to a minimum of Rs. 3,720.

2. The 'Pay' for the purpose of these orders shall be the 'Pay' as defined in Reg. 2.45(i) of the Punjab State Electricity Board MSR, Volume-I, Part-I, which is commonly known as 'Basic Pay', Non-Practising Allowance and stagnation increments in respect of employees drawing pay in the Revised Scales of Pay as per Pb. State Elec. Board (Revised Pay) Reg., 1988. In the case of employees who have not opted for the revised scales of pay but continue to draw pay in the pre-revised scales of pay, the 'Pay' for the purpose of these orders will include, in addition to 'Basic Pay' the Dearness Allowance, Dearness Pay, adhoc Dearness Allowance and Interim Relief (wherever allowed) appropriate to that pay admissible under orders in existence on the 1st January, 1986. In terms of Punjab Government Notification No. 3/15/IFCD/5988, dated the 11th July, 1990 (Published in Punjab Government Gazette (Extra), dated the 31st July, 1990) the dearness allowance is not admissible on

deputation allowance.

3. The payment on account of dearness allowance involving fraction of 50 paise or above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and the fraction of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

4. These orders are also applicable to the work-charged employees.

5. These orders will not be applicable to the staff paid from contingencies, casual labour, staff employed on daily wages and those working on piece-rate system. These orders will also not be applicable to those employed on contract basis except where dearness allowance is admissible in terms of their contract.

6. The amount of Dearness Allowance for the period from the 1st July, 1992 upto the 28th February 1993 in respect of the Board employees shall be credited to their General Provident Fund Accounts, that is the Additional Dearness Allowance due for payment from the 1st July, 1992 to the 28th February, 1993, would be drawn and credited in the General Provident Fund Accounts of the employees in April, 1993. Where any Board employee was during the said period, not eligible to subscribe to the Provident Fund, the drawal of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall be deferred till the employee concerned becomes eligible to contribute to the Provident Fund and the Provident Fund Account is opened in his/her name. In such a case, as and when the Provident Fund Account is opened and the amount of Dearness Allowance is credited thereto, interest will accrue from the 1st April, 1993. The Board employees who have retired or had closed their General Provident Fund Accounts before the issue of this order or who might close their accounts by the time the arrears are drawn, shall be paid the arrears of Dearness Allowance in cash in April, 1993.

7. In respect of the employees drawing pay above Rs.3,500 per month, the instalment of Dearness Allowance shall not be paid in cash but, instead, shall continue to be credited to their respective Provident Fund Accounts like regular subscriptions to this fund.

8. The payment of Dearness Allowance in cash, to the employees drawing pay upto Rs.3,500 per month, shall commence with effect from the 1st March, 1993 payable in April, 1993. Ready reckoner showing the amount of Dearness Allowance payable with effect from the 1st July, 1992 onwards in terms of these orders are appended (at Appendix).
