Subject:- Grant of Dearness Relief to the Pensioners/Family
Pensioners of the Government of Punjab- Revised
rates effective from 1st January, 2000.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite a reference to this Department
letter No. 1/29/98-1FP-3/15745, dated 16th November, 1999 sanction-
ing the instalment of dearness relief admissible from 1st July,
1999 and to say that the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide
that rate of dearness relief to Pensioners/Family Pensioners/
Extraordinary Pensioners etc. of the Government of Punjab shall be
revised from 37% to 38% with effect from 1st January, 2000 to
compensate them for the rise of cost of living beyond average
Consumer Price Index 306.33 (as on 1st January, 1996).

1.2 Payment of Dearness Relief involving fraction of a
rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

1.3 Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Relief to
pensioners etc. such as regulation of Dearness Relief during
employment/re-employment and regulation of Dearness Relief where
more than one pension is drawn etc. will remain unchanged.

1.4 On the analogy of decision taken by Government of India
it has been decided to dispense with the issue of ready reckoner
alongwith the Dearness Relief orders. It will now be the responsi-
bility of the Pension Disbursing Authority, including the national-
ised banks etc. to calculate the quantum of dearness relief payable
in each individual case.

1.5 All District Treasury Officers, Treasury Officers and
Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of Dearness
Relief to pensioners/Family Pensioners etc. on the basis of these
orders immediately.

2. The expenditure involved will be debited to the Head-
"2071- Pension and other Retirement Benefits."

3. The liability in respect of pre-1st November, 1966
service of the pensioners and their family pensioners shall be
divisible amongst the successor States of the erstwhile State
of Punjab i.e. Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Union Territory,
Chandigarh, in terms of 14th Schedule of Punjab Re-organisation
Act, 1966.



Subject: Placement of JES in the 2nd time bound promotional scale of AE already granted promotional scale of Rs. 2100/3700 - Clarification regarding.


Vide Finance Circular No. 6/2000 circulated vide this office memo No. 32645/683/Fin-II/V-5 dated 9th. March, 2000 a clarification was issued on a point of doubt whether such of the JES as are once granted the 2nd time bound promotional scale of Rs. 2100/3700 prescribed for DAE non-qualified officials, can be placed in the 2nd time bound promotional scale of AE viz Rs. 2200/4250 (without initial start of Rs. 2400/-), meant for qualified hands in their cadre eligible for promotion to the rank of AE, on their subsequently passing the said examination in view of F.C. No. 13/93 dated 1.3.93. The operative part of these clarificatory instructions reads as under :-

"It is clarified that F.C. 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



Sub:- Grant of LTC - Clarification thereof.

Vide Finance Circular No. 38/98 dated 18.9.98 the entitlements to travel by trains for availing the LTC were revised w.e.f. 1.10.1997 on Punjab Govt. pattern, according to which the employees were not entitled to travel by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express trains. As such it was clarified vide FC No. 48/99 dated 28.10.99 that no journey on these trains can be performed.

2. However, references were received from the field offices to the effect that the employees were entitled to travel by Rajdhani Express for LTC purposes as per previous instructions contained in FC No. 37/89 dated 15.5.89 and that some of the employees have had availed this facility under the impression that their earlier entitlement is intact. And, in case the claims of such of the employees on this account are not entertained, they are bound to suffer financial loss.

3. Upon re-consideration of the whole issue, it has been decided that the claims of such of the employees as were entitled to travel by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express as per their previous entitlements and have actually travelled by these trains in between 1.10.97 to 28.10.99 - the date of issuance of clarificatory instructions, will be entertained as per their previous entitlements.

4. It has further been decided to allow the employees to travel as per their revised entitlements (Notified vide FC No. 38/98 dated 18.9.98) in the same class in Rajdhani or

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
corresponding status class available in Shatabdi Express
as under :-

- i) The employees who are entitled to travel by AC First Class can also travel in the same class in Rajdhani Express or Executive Class in Shatabdi Express.
- ii) Those who are entitled to travel by AC 2-tier can also travel in the same class in Rajdhani Express or AC Chair Car in Shatabdi Express.
- iii) Similarly, those entitled to travel by First Class/AC 3-tier can also travel by AC-3 tier in Rajdhani or AC Chair Car in Shatabdi Express.

Note:- Entitlement by Rajdhani/Shatabdi trains would be applicable in cases where journey is actually undertaken by these trains and not for determining entitlement on notional basis. Both ends of the journey, i.e. the place of start of the journey and the destination should be directly connected by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express. This is further subject to the clarifications issued by the Govt. of India vide their No. 31011/8/98-Estt.(A) dated 31.3.99 (copy enclosed).

5. The revised entitlements will be effective prospectively.

Subject:- Regulation of LTC claim for journeys performed
by non-entitled modes/class of accommodation.

Consequent upon implementation of the recommendations of the Fifth Central Pay Commission. CCS(LTC) Rules were amended vide this Department's Notifications No. 31011/7/97-Estt.(A) dated 28.10.1997(GSR No. 602-E) and 28.7.1998(GSR No. 412-E) (vide Sl.No. 200 of Swamy's Annual, 1997 and Sl.No. 207 of Swamy's News, September, 1998 respectively). Certain clarifications have been sought by various Ministries/Departments from time to time. The doubts raised by various authorities are clarified as under:-

Points raised

1. Can an employee be entitled to travel by air travel via a station connected by air services even if the Home Town/declared place of visit is not directly connected by air services?
2. Entitlement for journey by train has been modified through the Notification, dated 28.7.1998, which came into force with effect from 1.10.1998. How the entitlement will be determined for a journey performed prior to 1st October, 1998.
3. If an employee commenced his outward journey before 1.10.1998 but returned after 1.10.1998 how his claim shall be regulated.
4. LTC orders provide for journey by AC Chair Car in Rajdhani Express Trains by employees in the pay range of Rs.4,100 and above but less than Rs.8,000. In cases where Chair car is not provided, can an employee travel by AC 3-Tier sleeper on such trains and claim reimbursement accordingly?

Clarifications

An employee entitled to travel by air can travel by the national carriers (and not by private airlines) to airport nearest to the Home Town or the declared place of visit in case where these are not directly connected by air service. The air journey in such cases shall, however, be performed by the shortest direct route.

The entitlement of an officer is to be determined strictly in terms of the orders in force and applicable on the date of commencement of the outward journey.

The claim shall be regulated strictly in terms of the orders in force on the date of commencement of the outward journey.

Travel by Rajdhani Express is a special concession provided in the LTC Rules. In the circumstances, reimbursement of AC tier sleeper fare on trains in which Chair car accommodation is not provided will not be permissible and the claim shall be restricted only to the applicable Chair car fare.

5. LTC orders permit journeys by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express Trains. Can the entitlement be determined on notional basis ?
- 2.
- No. In order to be entitled to reimbursement of fares applicable on Rajdhani or Shatabdi Express, the journeys in question have to be actually performed by these trains. In cases where LTC journeys are undertaken in trains other than Rajdhani or Shatabdi Express by a class of accommodation higher than the one to which the employee is entitled to or by an alternative mode of travel (e.g. by air) to which he/she is not entitled, reimbursements of fares cannot be determined on a notional basis with reference to the fares applicable by the entitled class on the Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express.
6. LTC orders provide for journey by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express Trains where both the originating and destination stations are directly connected by these trains. Can an employee travel by these trains if the Home Town/declared place of visit is not directly connected by rail but the nearest Railway Station is directly connected by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Trains?
- This will be permissible provided the employee concerned is entitled to travel by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express on LTC.
7. If the Home town of an employee is connected by train but is not directly connected by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express Trains. In such a case can the employee be entitled to travel partly by Rajdhani Shatabdi Express Trains and partly by other trains.
- If the journey is actually performed by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Trains up to an enroute railway station by direct shortest route and thereafter the journey is completed in a train other than Rajdhani/Shatabdi trains fare for both the types of trains by the entitled class would be admissible for the respective portion of journey.
8. Whether reimbursement is permissible in cases where an employee travels by a longer route or breaks journey when he is travelling only by Rajdhani Express Trains. Can the reimbursement in such cases be restricted to the fare applicable on Rajdhani Express Trains by the shortest direct route or will only be ordinary train fare be admissible ?
- Reimbursement of fares by the entitled class of accommodation applicable on Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express by the shortest direct route, shall be permissible provided all the legs of the journey are actually performed exclusively by these trains and both the originating and destination stations are directly connected by these trains.

Contd.

1. 9. If an employee travels partly by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express Trains and partly by other train(s) or by any other mode of transport, such as ship, bus, etc. how is the LTC claim to be regulated ?
2. As already clarified at Sl.No. 7 above, in cases where travel on LTC is performed partly by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express and partly by other trains/ modes of transport, the claim shall be reimburseable subject to the condition that the journey is performed by the shortest route.
10. Certain places are not directly connected by trains and one has to change train at nearest rail head. In such cases can journey be undertaken up to nearest rail head which is connected by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express ?
- Clarification in respect of Sl.No.9 may be seen in this connection.
11. If the originating and terminating points fall on the routes of Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express Trains but these trains do not halt at these stations, can an employee travel by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express and claim reimbursement ?
- The employee can travel by Rajdhani/Shatabdi Express up to the nearest enroute station which should not be beyond the destination, i.e. Home Town or the declared place of visit.
12. If two stations are connected by direct trains but the route travelled by such trains is not the shortest, can the fare applicable for travel by the direct longer route be reimbursed in full ?
- Yes, provided travel by the longer route on LTC has been specifically recognized and approved by the Government in terms of the separate orders issued in this regard from time to time.
13. Revised LTC orders permit travel by private vehicles i.e. Taxi, Autorickshaw, etc. It may be clarified whether the orders prohibiting LTC journeys by road in a private hired vehicle or by own vehicles have been withdrawn. If so, in such cases, can the claim be restricted to the bus fare or the fare actually paid ?
- Journeys on LTC by taxi, autorickshaw, etc. are permissible only between places which are not connected by rail. This is further subject to the condition that these modes of transports operate on a regular basis from point to point with the specific approval of the State Govt. Transport Authorities concerned and are authorized to ply as public carriers. The existing restrictions on travel by private chartered vehicles, own vehicles, etc. shall, therefore, continue to be in force and applicable. No reimbursement shall be permissible in such cases.

1. 14. If journeys on LTC are performed by taxi or autorickshaw between stations connected by rail and/or bus, can the LTC claim be restricted to the bus fare? If not, what amount be admissible?

2. Journeys by taxi, autorickshaw etc. are permissible only between places not connected by rail and subject to the further condition that these operate on a regular basis from point to point with the specific approval of the State Governments/Transport Authorities concerned. Journeys by these modes on LTC are not permissible between places connected by rail.

15. Can claims in respect of local journeys performed by taxi, autorickshaw, etc. from the residence to the Railway Station, airport etc. and vice-versa be restricted to the applicable bus fare?

Incidental expenditure incurred on local journeys between the residence place of stay and the airport/ Railway Station/bus terminal are not reimbursable.

16. LTC Rules provide that when a journey is performed by taxi, autorickshaw, etc. the claim shall be restricted to the entitled bus fare. However, various State Roadways Corporations operate on the same route but have different fare structures. How will the claim be regulated in such a situation?

When journey on LTC is actually undertaken by buses operated by a State Roadways Corporation, the actual fare paid by the entitled type of bus shall be reimbursable. AS clarified against Sl.No. 13, journeys on LTC by taxi, autorickshaw etc. are permissible only between places not connected by rail and subject to the conditions specified. When journeys are performed by these modes, and more than one State Roadways Corporation operate on the route, the lowest fare applicable on the route is reimbursable.



The Punjab State Electricity Board is pleased to decide as under:-

- i) The existing rate of Cash Handling Allowance admissible to the LDC (Cashiers) is enhanced from Rs. 125/- P.M. to Rs. 200/- P.M. w.e.f. 1.9.97.
- ii) The benefit of promotional increment(s) as admissible since 26.11.1992 will continue to be allowed in future on the appointment of an LDC as Cashier.
- iii) In respect of those appointed as Cashier prior to 26.11.92, the component of special pay of Rs. 75/- granted in lieu of separate higher time scale and drawn as on 31.12.95, will X. be treated as part of basic pay for the purpose of commuting the existing emoluments as per provisions of Reg. 3(a) & (c) of the PSEB (Revised Pay) Regulations, 1993 for fixation of pay in the revised scales effective from 1.1.1996.
- iv) The component of increments/special pay so granted will be merged in the pay if the official continues to work as Cashier till his promotion to the next higher rank. However, in the event of an incumbent reverting back to his original position of LDC, this benefit will be liable to be withdrawn and his pay in the capacity of LDC will be re-fixed on presumptive basis-what he would have drawn had he not been appointed as Cashier.
- v) LDCs/UDCs deployed by the AE/AEES (Operation) to carry out the duties of Cashiers at the cash counter in case of cashier's absence on leave or otherwise shall be paid Rs. 25/- per day subject to maximum of Rs. 250/- P.M. (The ceiling will not be applicable in case of vacant post of cashier). This will take prospective effect.

2.- The arrears accruing from re-fixation of pay, if any, and enhancement in Cash Handling Allowance will be credited to the GPF accounts of the employees concerned, payable in cash with effect from 1.8.2000. For retired employees, the arrears will be paid in cash as per existing policy of the Board.





Sub:- Grant of benefit of Travel Concession to the Punjab Govt. Pensioner.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to the Finance Deptt. letter No. 1/15/89-1FP-III/8078 dated 31st Aug. 1989 on the subject cited above. In para-9 of these instructions it has been laid down that for grant of Travel Concession, calendar year will start from January of the year succeeding full two years after retirement.

2.- Various Pensioners Associations have represented that by adopting this procedure employees retiring in the month of January have to wait for three years to get the Travel Concession. The matter has been reconsidered and it has been decided that for grant of Travel Concession, the calendar year will start as under:-

- i) Employees retiring between 1st January to 30th June, the calendar year will start from 1st July;
- ii) Employees retiring between 1st July to 31st December, the calendar year will start from 1st January of succeeding year.

3.- The above orders will take effect immediately.



I am directed to refer to this Department Circular letter No. 3/2/97-FPI/5485 dated the 9th May, 2000, on the subject cited above and to say that the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide that the Dearness Allowance payable to Punjab Government employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 38% to 41% of pay with effect from the 1st July, 2000. The amount due from 1st July, 2000, under these orders shall be paid in cash.
