2. The 'Pay' for the purpose of these orders shall
be the 'Pay' as defined in Rule 2.45(1) of the Punjab State Electri-
city Board MSR, Volume-I, Part-I, which is commonly known as
'Basic Pay', Non-Practising Allowance and stagnation increments
in respect of employees drawing pay in the Revised scales of
Pay as per Pb. State Electy. Board (Revised Pay) Reg. , 1938. In the
case of employees who have not opted for the revised scales of
pay but continue to draw pay in the pre-revised scales of pay,
the 'Pay' for the purpose of these orders will include, in

addition to 'Basic Pay' the Dearness Allowance, Dearness Pay, adhoc Dearness Allowance and Interim Relief (wherever allowed) appropriate to that pay admissible under orders in existence on the 1st January, 1986. In terms of Punjab Government Notification No. 3/15/IFCD/5988, dated the 11th July, 1990 (Published in Punjab Government Gazette (Extra), dated the 31st July, 1990) the dearness allowance is not admissible on deputation allowance.

3. The payment on account of dearness allowance involving fraction of 50 paise or above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and the fraction of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

4. These orders are also applicable to the work-charged employees.

5. These orders will not be applicable to the staff paid from contingencies, casual labour, staff employed on daily wages and those working on piece-rate system. These orders will also not be applicable to those employed on contract basis except where Dearness allowance is admissible in terms of their contract.

6. The amount of Dearness Allowance for the period from the 1st July, 1991, upto the 31st December, 1991, in respect of the Board employees drawing pay above Rs. 3500 and from the 1st January 1992, to the 30th April, 1992, in respect of all Board employees, shall be credited to the General Provident Fund Accounts of the Board employees, such credit being deemed to have been made on the 1st May, 1992, where any Board employee was during the said period, not eligible to subscribe to the Provident Fund, the drawal of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall be deferred till the employee concerned becomes eligible to contribute to the Provident Fund and the Provident Fund Account is opened in his/her name. In such a case, as and when the Provident Fund Account is opened and the amount of Dearness Allowance is credited thereto, interest will accrue from the 1st May, 1992. The Board employees who have retired or had closed their General Provident Fund Account before the issue of

this order or who might close their accounts by the time the arrears are drawn, shall be paid the arrears of Dearness Allowance in cash.

7. The payment of Dearness Allowance in cash, shall commence with effect from the 1st May, 1992, i.e., in the pay bills for the month of May, 1992, payable in May, 1992. Ready reckoners showing the amount of Dearness Allowance payable with effect from the 1st July, 1991, and with effect from the 1st January, 1992, onwards in terms of these orders are appended (Appendices I&II)

Subject:- House Rent Allowance in lieu of rent free accommodation -revised rate.

Sir,

I am directed ^{to} state that prior to the 1st Sept., 1988, the employees posted in the belt of 16 Kms. from the international border were allowed House Rent Allowance equivalent to first class city in lieu of rent free accommodation when the requisite accommodation was not provided. The matter was considered by the Government in the light of recommendation of the Third Punjab Pay Commission and it was decided that additional payment towards House Rent Allowance in lieu of rent free accommodation where accommodation could not be provided should be allowed equal to the House Rent charged by the Government from the employees for Government accommodation apart from the normal house rent allowance, if admissible, in that particular place. It was decided vide this Department letter No. 10/77/88-FPI/10312, dated the 24th November, 1988, to charge house rent at 5% from the employees for Government accommodation. Accordingly, it was decided that Government employees entitled to rent free accommodation, when not provided allotted such accommodation, shall be allowed payment equal to house rent allowance charged by the Government from employees.

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for Government accommodation that is 5% of the basic pay, in addition to the normal house rent allowance, if admissible at the place of posting and this decision was conveyed vide this Department letter No. 10/77/88-FPI/11470, dated the 23rd Dec., 1988.

2. In spite of the clear instructions issued in regard to the payment of house rent allowance in lieu of rent free accommodation, it has been observed that employees posted at places in the belt of 16 Kms. from the international border and those who are otherwise entitled to rent free accommodation are being paid house rent allowance in excess of what is actually admissible under the instructions. All the Drawing and Disbursing Officers may, therefore, be directed to ensure that the payment of house rent allowance in lieu of rent free accommodation should be made strictly in accordance with the existing instructions which are reiterated below:-

- a) Government employees entitled to rent free accommodation, when not provided/allotted such accommodation shall be allowed payment equal to the house rent charged by the Government from the employees for Government accommodation, i.e., 5% of the basic pay, in addition to the normal house rent allowance, if admissible, at the place of posting. This implies that the employees posted at the places in the belt of 16 Kms. from the international border who are entitled to rent free accommodation as also other employees who are otherwise entitled to rent free accommodation will get 5% of the basic pay in addition to the house rent allowance, if the place of posting of the employees falls in Class-'A' cities, Class-'B' cities, Class-'C' cities or Class-'D' towns, as the case may be, in accordance with the instructions contained in the Department of Finance letter No. 10/7/88-FPI/8014 dated the 30th August, 1988. It is made clear that the amount of house rent allowance of first class cities admissible before 1.9.1988 to the employees posted in the belt of 15 Kms. of International border is not covered within the protection of the house rent allowance, as this amount of house rent allowance was admissible in lieu of rent free accommodation only.
- b) In the rural areas, house rent allowance is not admissible to the Government employees who, prior to 1.9.1988, were entitled to house rent allowance of first class cities or the second class cities as the case may be. The Government employees posted in the rural areas who are entitled to rent free

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accommodation when not provided such accommodation, are entitled to 5% of the basic pay, in addition to rural area allowance and nothing more. In view of this position, the employees posted in rural areas, who, prior to 1.9.1938, were drawing house rent allowance in accordance with the earlier instructions in lieu of rent free accommodation are not entitled to be given any protection of the amount of house rent allowance which they were claiming previously.

3. The above instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance. It should be ensured that no over-payment is made to any employee who is to be given house rent allowance, etc., in lieu of rent free accommodation.
