01. Download and Install Java using below link: -



Step-1. Copy this URL: https://erpappssit.pspcl.in


Step-2. Go to control panel and click "Java"








Step-3. Click on "Security"




Step-4. Click on "Edit Site List"








Step-5 Click on "Add"



Step-6. Paste the URL under location and click and "OK"




Java is configured successfully.






Now open any internet browser like Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox and Edge browser and Copy-paste the URL. https://erpappssit.pspcl.in


Click on "frmservlet.jnlp" to run JAVA form like below
