- 3. Peak Load exemption charges @50% to be charged for the period during which restriction on peak load exemptions remained applicable.

- 5. The field officers were requested to display the relevant circulars on the notice boards of complaint centres as well as Sub Divn. offices/Grid Sub Stations.
